

ROADKILL COMBAT STICKERS



These stickers are a sort of homage to those who have had to deal with stuff a bit sterner than road hazards, but the concept is similar. (and occasionally the danger).

Roadkill stickers are best cut out using a steel straightedge and a #11 type art blade. Scissors work OK too. They look good when located on the lower edge of windscreens or wherever you would like to display your roster of encounters with stuff you would have rather not encountered. If you apply them on a transparent surface, some light bur-nishing will help them blend in. And if you wrecked your last bike as a result of hitting something, feel free to put the image on your new bike. It's an ongoing tally thing...
