This horn provides extra fun because unlike the typically slightly louder (and slightly smaller) models such as the 139 dB Ear Cannon Air Horn, the Nautilus II puts out a deep, low locomotive-semi-truck-ocean-liner-primal-predator honk. Even at its 110 dB level, this is not what drivers are expecting. It's definitely enough to make them drop their cell phones. Featuring an incorporated mini-compressor and tuned horn that bellows out an earth quaking blast previously only achievable by horns five times larger. It reportedly installs easily.

Makes two-wheels sound like eighteen. Can you hear me now?

Historical Route Maps

Unfurling this stunning 1915 reproduction of a super-rare original pen and ink hand-drawn USA route and trail map transports one to a time when brave riders set out across country in search of discoveries that lay around the next bend or over the next hill. This historical coast-to-coast map predates the numbered highway system, and a detailed legend shows classic route markers and signage used



during this time of our nation's emerging system of connecting roadways. On the other side is a national road map from 1931 showing the transition from locally named roads to the beginnings of today's modern and more orderly numbering system.

A fascinating full-color dual-sided map, beautifully reproduced down to the most intricate details. It's a frame able piece of early motor way history that looks stunning on the wall, and will fill any rider's soul with the wanderlust to locate and ride the historic sections of these old roads that still exist today. Boom Boom Audio System

If loud pipes are not your thing but good, loud music is, well, music to your ears you may want to



ask Santa for Harley-Davidson's new Boom Audio Custom Touring System.

The Boom Audio System from Harley-Davidson Genuine Motor Accessories is a complete audio system engineered to deliver unsurpassed audio performance in an outdoor environment. The system combines fairing, fairing lower and saddlebagmounted speakers to envelop the rider and passenger in music. System-matched to the original-equipment Advanced Audio Radio on many Harley-Davidson Touring models, this kit includes: two two-channel, 100-watt amplifiers (fairing and saddlebag); two 5.25-inch fairing speakers; two 2-inch tweeter pods; two 6.5-inch midrange fairing lower speakers; and two full-range saddlebag lid speakers, plus all required wiring and mounting hardware.

The system fits certain 2006 and later models. Requires separate purchase of a vented color-matched fairing lower kit and appropriate saddlebag lids. It's not compatible with Tour-Pak luggage, Heavy Breather Air Cleaner and some audio accessories. Special software update is required and dealer installation is recommended. The Boom Boom system costs \$1,896.

A saddlebag speaker kit will run another \$370 and a Boom fairing lower speaker kit costs \$220. See a Harley-Davidson dealer for more details.

Boom Boom Tank Pouch

If you're spending all this money for an outstanding audio upgrade you might as well go all the way with a magnetic Tank Pouch to hold your favorite tunes stored on an iPod or other MP3 player. The pouch has a neoprene jacket to protect a portable music device, while built-in magnets hold the pouch securely to any steel fuel tank or airbox cover. The clear window permits touch-screen control, and the anti-skid interior allows the pouch to accommodate players of various sizes. The clamshell design makes inserting a player into the pouch quick and (continued on page 24)
